

Instructions on how to vote for the Green Party in the council elections using the ballot paper posted to you



Your postal vote pack will arrive with you between 17th and 24th April. Once you've received it, please read the instructions below and be sure to post back to the Council your completed paperwork as soon as possible.

Please vote for Steve, Pippa and Benjamin in St Helier.

COLES, Steve	 Green Party	X
MASLIN, Pippa	 Green Party	X
SMITH, Benjamin	 Green Party	X

Once completed, put your ballot paper in the smaller of the two envelopes provided (envelope A) and seal it up.

There's also a Postal Voting Statement which you must complete. On this statement, you need to fill in two things - your **DATE OF BIRTH** and your **SIGNATURE** - keeping them within the boxes.

Now, place the Postal Voting Statement in the larger of the two envelopes (envelope B), along with envelope A. Then, seal and post - no need for a stamp!
